The VRCC Chair and Vice-Chair are presently working on getting a credit from the convention center because the Elevators and Escalators were not working. The VRCC chair did receive a voicemail from the legal coordinator for the Virginia Beach Convention Center on February 5th and they are preparing a response by the week of Feb 10th. The VRCC attorney recommended rooms upstairs not accessible for the convention a \$4,146.00 credit, plus \$500 for loss of merchandise sales, total credits of \$4,646.00. According to the contract, because of equipment failure, this violated the Americans with Disabilities Act. The city may and can terminate the agreement. NA is fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions. The 38th AVCNA also received rebate checks back from the Doubletree hotel and the Fairfield Inn. Both hotels also sold out. The 38th also hung their own banners, which cut costs. The body is expecting an updated financial report in March at the next VRCC meeting.
