Attached for your review is the April 2023 bank statement, income and expense report, and a simplified profit and loss statement. If you have any questions, please see me.</p> <p>Income for April 2023 is \$4,676.53 and expenses were \$2,830.59 and \$1,412.29 in outstanding checks.</p> <p>Our reconciled check book balance is \$9,852.04 which includes \$3,064.00 for Prudent Reserve \$1,000 in Special Events escrow and \$200.00 in Special Events seed money, and an outstanding check for \$1,412.29. This gives us \$5,588.04 over Prudent Reserve.</p> <p>The following checks are outstanding: Check # 5274 to New Dominion for \$136.80 Check # 5272 to WSO/NAWS for \$1,275.49 Check # 5272 was destroyed by the Post Office, ASC Chair discovered when she checked the P.O. Box for me, and I will be sending that to WSO this month with the literature order.</p> <p>I have collected the receipts from the Learning Day event that was held in March in the amount of \$194.38. This left \$5.62 from the \$200.00 and I should be receiving that amount from Outreach today.</p> <p>There was a charge on the bank statement for a charge back of \$310.00 and a 415.00 fee was added to that. Per the bank a stop payment was issued on the money order given by Growing In Recovery home group. This \$310.00 included a donation to Area for \$50.00 and a \$210.00 literature order.
