The other two regions are planning to leave the autonomy zone which means we have to find another zone. For several months several delegates went to other zones gathering information and bringing it back to the region. Currently, where we are is the Northeast zone and the southeast zone were seemingly the best option for us to look into as they are the closest to us because we are right in the middle. I am asking for a vote on if we want to join the southeast or the northeast region. From asking questions at the last Regional meeting I believe the NE region would be the best fit for us here's why. In the NE and the SE they have already established task groups to assist with areas that the region may be struggling with. They are the same in that way except it seems to me that the NE zone has far more experienced members apart of their task groups. Moreover the NE zone is the most active zone in the whole USA, and the function of a zone is to be able to do things in service that a single region could not do which is why our zone was suffering due to such limited regions.</p> <p>Moreover, I have asked for a \$500.00 donation to take to region for next month.
