Research has been requested and information on that matter should be presented today. There has not been a purchase of a printer made yet. The Vice Chair and I have already viewed one location and are currently searching for other alternatives. The group created the Print Shop Subcommittee and delegated to it the duties and responsibilities of printing all Area materials as stated in the Guidelines and Procedures, Concept 5. However, the Area's Executive Body, which is not identified in the Guidelines and Procedures, have been making decisions on which printer to purchase and printing the Area's literature in violation of the 5th, 6th, 8th, and 11th Concepts.</p> <p>Concept 5: For each responsibility assigned to the service structure, a single point of decision and accountability should be clearly defined. The Print Shop Subcommittee should have been the lead and a part of the decision-making process in our search for a new printer.</p> <p>Concept 6: Group conscience is the spiritual means by which we invite a loving God to influence our decisions. The Print Shop was not included in the group conscience of purchasing a printer.</p> <p>Concept 8: Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications. The Executive Body, which we do not have, nearly purchased and inappropriate printer due to its lack of experience and knowledge of our printing needs. Concept 11: NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose and must be managed responsibly. Failure to adhere to the Areas' Guidelines and Procedures and the 12 Concepts have resulted in the mismanagement of roughly \$615.00 of NA funds and we still do not have a printer as of this meeting.</p> <p>The Print Shop Subcommittee asks that the purchasing of a printer be placed in New Business for discussion and an Area group conscience and guidance today.
