#### 13. New Business:

#### **Guideline Motion**

a. <u>Motion</u>: To amend the Guidelines & Procedures page 16 section 4 subsection fa as well as page 17 section 5 subsection 5a as they pertain to the literature stockpiles for the subcommittee and the facilitators. The majority of the facilities that H&I serves are short term facilities with many residents only there for appx. 90 days. Our area of H&I also serves correctional institutions that have strict policies regarding who can enter and what can be brought in. These updated stockpiles reflect the changing needs of the Richmond Area Hospitals & Institutions subcommittee and the facilities we serve.

<u>Intent:</u> To ensure that the commitments taken on by this subcommittee are fulfilled to the best of our ability. As needs change within the subcommittee and the facilities we serve, updating RASCNA Guidelines & Procedures is vital.

Concept # 1: To fulfill our fellowship's primary purpose, the NA Groups have joined together to create a structure which develops, coordinates, and maintains Services on behalf of NA as a whole.

Concept # 11: NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly.

Changes to the subcommittee and facilitator stockpiles that the H&I subcommittee approved and voted on are as follows:

- 1. The NA White Booklets H&I Edition will take the place of the NA White Booklets and the Behind the Walls Booklets
- 2. The White "Just For Today" key tags will be the only key tags used and all other key tags will change to chips. This change is a cost saving change, key tags are \$0.56 per key tag while chips are \$0.40 per chip.
- 3. The only other changes made to the stockpiles are the amounts of items already in use.

Ex: Correctional institutions require that facilitators complete classes (PREA, CPR, First Aid, ect.) and pass security checks. Any literature items taken inside cannot contain any metal, therefore, the facilitator cannot take any key tags or items containing staples.

<u>Intent:</u> To give the H&I subcommittee the authority to adjust what an individual facilitator needs when serving the facilities with stricter policies. Concept # 1: To fulfill our fellowship's primary purpose, the NA Groups have joined together to create a structure which develops, coordinates, and maintains Services on behalf of NA as a whole.
