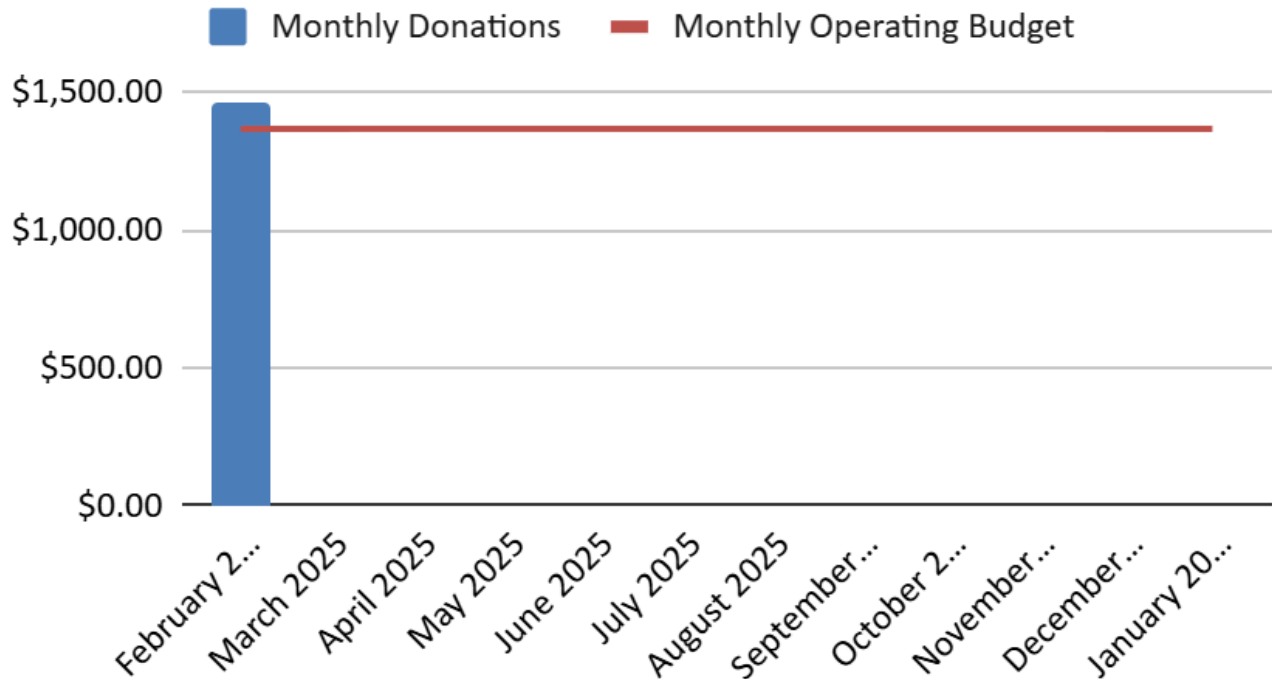

Hey Family,

Last month marked the first fiscal month of fiscal year 2025. After passing the new budget, our new monthly operating budget is \$1,366.67. Donations last month totaled \$1,463.10. This amounts to a surplus of \$96.43.

For the sake of transparency, I also want to report that due to the way that the fiscal year fell. There was an H&I literature order that came in right before the end of the fiscal year and that money was transferred from the H&I budget from last fiscal year to the Literature budget for this fiscal year so that literature could be replenished rather than sent as part of the donation to CARNA when the fiscal year was closed out. If anyone has any questions or concerns about this, please let me know.

Also, I attended the GSR learning day that was hosted in this room on February 16th and think it was a successful event. I look forward to having more of these in the future.

Motion: To suspend NDANA policy requiring 2 signatures on checks for this meeting only.

Motion 2-25-1 [read by Bryan M] – MOTION PASSED

Motion: To delete section 1 subpoint q) GSR/ASC Positions in New Dominion Area policy and replace with the following:

ASC/GSR positions

NA members may hold a GSR position and one other subcommittee chair position at the Area level. ASC Executive/Administrative Committee members (to include Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, and Vice Treasurer) shall not hold any other ASC positions including voting GSR or Sub-Committee chairs.

Intent: To prevent conflicts of interest and create a clear delineation of authority and to ensure that the Executive/Administrative body remains responsible to the GSRs of the New Dominion Area.

Motion 2-25-3 [read by Bryan M] – MOTION TABLED; MOTION IS TO RETURN TO HOMEGROUPS AGAIN IN LIGHT OF DISCUSSION BELOW

Motion: To make Treasurer and Vice Treasurer two-year positions.

Intent: To have the treasury run smoothly. It takes a year to learn the position and a year to keep it going smoothly.

Point of interest: Would not go into effect until beginning of next term.

Discussion around this motion which took place before voting was called:

- **Cam B [GSR Riverside]:** As was brought up during the Treasurer's Report earlier, this change would turn the position into a 4 year commitment.
- **Pam K [GSR Keep Coming Back]:** Vice doesn't necessarily have to become treasurer, it's not necessarily a longer commitment. And vice only has to do one year, not two.
- **Mackenzie M [VRCC Alt & GSR Vision Without Limits]:** Was this motion brought because of the mess that the current Treasurer and Vice had to walk into?
- **Linda C [RCM & GSR Alt. Survivors]:** Yes.

- **Whitney S [GSR Find Your Tribe]:** Can you reread the motion?
- **Nick M [Policy Chair]** read the motion as written above.
- **Whitney S:** The motion clearly states it's a two year position for both treasurer AND vice, the point made earlier that vice treasurer would only need to do one year is contradicted by the motion itself.
- **Scott M [Vice Treasurer]:** Being in this role, two years is already a lot. Finding someone to fill the role will be difficult if they have to serve such a long time.
- **Linda C:** You two are both in your second term, so clearly it won't be difficult to fill this role. It's taken all this time for it to be run smoothly.
- **Deb W [Treasurer]:** I think what we need is a written procedure, so that whoever steps into the role has some guidance. Treasurer should be teaching the Vice and preparing them for the role.
- **Robert C [GSR Just for Today]:** I took this back to my HG with the impression it was needed, but now I'm hearing from Treasurer and Vice Treasurer that it isn't necessary, but if we vote I would have to carry the vote that my homegroup had.

Open Forum:

Sebastian S advised that I Can't We Can is looking for people to announce their need for members and attendance. PowPow explained that's what ESH list is for: I Can't We Can will be added to the list along with all homegroups which asked for support in their report. That list is included as an attachment to the emailed minutes, and is also forwarded to Outreach and to those that manage the RVANA website.

Robert C asked if Special Events could lend some coffee makers and other non-consumable NDANA-owned supplies for use at a sponsorship family event.
