Treasurer:

- We have a balance of 17,937.51 in our Truist as of August 31, 2025. Last month's expenses totalled \$1555.36 and 7th tradition income of \$1648.25. A total of \$2746.36 was deposited into our account which included 7th tradition and literature.
- NDA will send CARNA a donation of \$ 568.55 this month as per policy.
- We have 1 uncleared check for \$35.46 and I have contacted the check recipient to follow up.
- I need to report a series of errors made by me on May 18. The PR Chair had given me a Funds request for \$333.59. Error 1 is that I entered it onto our expense spread sheet as \$28.00. Error 2 is that I listed it under H&I budget. Error 3 was that I wrote the check to PR chair for \$339.59. So, besides not having a clue what I was thinking, I need to apologize to everyone for not being focused and alert that day. I have fixed the spreadsheets to match the check written and the check was cleared a while back. This was clearly a documentation error. The only outstanding issue is that the check I wrote for \$339.59 is \$6 over the receipts/funds request form. In speaking with PR chair, he expressed feeling comfortable with reducing this month's funds request by \$6. I have also offered to cover the \$6 myself if for any reason Area Service members feel that would be more appropriate. I will be more vigilant in my documentation and am going to set up a check/balance system for myself so that errors like these can be caught within a reasonable time frame. I apologize for my lack of due diligence.

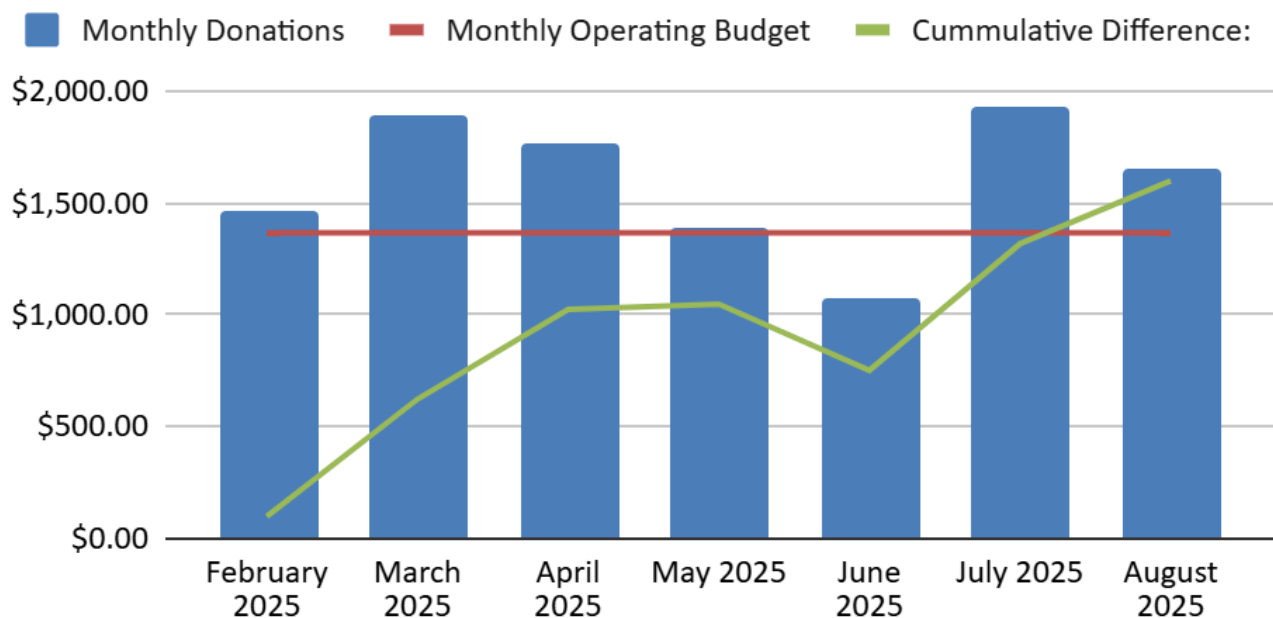

Vice-Treasurer:

Hey Family,

Last month we exceeded our donation target. As a reminder our monthly budget is \$1366.67. Last month we brought in \$1648.25 in donations which is a monthly surplus of \$281.58 and a year to date surplus of \$1599.12. As always, I have included a pretty graph to show this information. As a point of clarification on this - while we have taken in a surplus of almost \$1600 in total this year we do not have this as usable surplus as we do make a donation every other month.

Also, one of the checks that we received from the campout last month ended up bouncing, however as soon as we were made aware of the issue, I was able to work with the campout chair to quickly rectify the situation and they were able to obtain a cashier's check for the missing amount that I anticipate will be received today. This has resulted in a change to the previously reported Campout income to \$1240 instead of \$3055 for July 2025. The additional \$1815 will be recorded as income today and should reflect on the account for next month (provided the check is received today).

Also, as of today, there is a total of \$6990.50 that has been accrued but not been spent by various subcommittees. If you have questions about your budgets, please let me know!

RCM & RCM Alternate:

CARNA - RSC met on August 16, 2025

Quorum was not met - 11 Areas present.

The Regional Delegates are involved in prioritizing of the Conference Agenda Report. The US Collaboration of Zones Met and they attended. If you would like to know more about that we can get the information from Sherry.

They met with the Northeast Zone virtually and the budget for them will be made on October 18th.

The Regional Delegates want us to remember to budget for the Northeast zonal meeting in October. It will be a two day event and at the cost of \$650. That's within the budget.

The Regional Delegates want us to start budgeting for their trip to the World Service Conference.

There was a motion to set meeting location at the Louisa Public Library, 881 Davis Hwy, Mineral VA 23117. The exceptions would be Oct. 2025, April 2026 and August 2026. Those meetings will be between quadrants for two day GSR Assemblies or RSCs per policy. Budget for the meetings at the library will be \$100 or \$500 per year. Motion passed.

Motion to go back to Homegroups— For the period of October 1, 2025 to February 1, 2026, that the Central Atlantic Region Treasurer suspend donations to NAWs. After that time the 2026 RSC budget should be active.

The intent of this motion is to allow the groups and Areas of the CARNA Region to discern clarity of the Region Guidelines (section IX, 4A, 8:) regarding the calculation of contributions to NAWs.

RSC Guidelines: After expenses are paid and prudent reserve is met, all remaining money will be donated to NAWs.

(this is a request to temporarily suspend active Policy so it will only happen with the agreement of the homegroups by 2/3rds agreement.)

The two day RSC will be Oct. 18 - 19th. Open forum will be at 11:00 instead of 10:00. I believe the Quadrant is at the Beach Area and the place TBD. Please remember that our budget includes expenses for this RSC.

Regional Motions:

Linda re-read regional motion:

Motion to go back to Homegroups–

Motion: For the period of October 1, 2025 to February 1, 2026, that the Central Atlantic Region Treasurer suspend donations to NAWS. After that time the 2026 RSC budget should be active.

Intent: The intent of this motion is to allow the groups and Areas of the CARNA Region to discern clarity of the Region Guidelines (section IX, 4A, 8:) regarding the calculation of contributions to NAWS.

RSC Guidelines: After expenses are paid and prudent reserve is met, all remaining money will be donated to NAWS.

Point of clarification: This is a request to temporarily suspend active Policy so it will only happen with the agreement of the homegroups by 2/3rds agreement.

Discussion around the motion [including some points made earlier during Reports]:

- This motion will be voted on at Region in October.
- Region currently donates to NAWS every other month, after Region. The motion, if approved, would suspend 3 months of payments to NAWS, but once Region figures out how much money they're supposed to be sending, that money would still go to NAWS. They are asking for time to figure that out.
- In June, CARNA made a large donation to NAWS, which did not leave money for other budgeted items [see July minutes for further details].
- Region is struggling, with only a few people holding it down and a lack of donations from CARNA's Areas.
- No funds have been misappropriated.
- PowPow read from July's NDANA ASC minutes, from the RCM report:

“There was a lengthy discussion on donation to World. We did not make a donation last year. There was some confusion on Policy with the donation. We ended up making a donation of \$30,000 to World. There was no motion to do so. That did not leave money for already budgeted items, such as the Regional adhoc committee established to do an NA exhibit at the VA insti. for addiction professionals.”
