Hey Family,

Last month we did meet our donation target. As a reminder our monthly allocated budget is \$1366.67. Last month we brought in \$1,375.64 which is \$8.93 above our donation target. The attached graph shows the recorded donations versus allocated budget for this year.

In discussions with the Treasurer, we have come across an issue regarding the way we handle our literature budget with respect to making our end of year donations to region and world. Technically, based on our policy, as of the end of January, we are supposed to take all remaining unallocated funds and send as a donation - 70% to region, 30% to world. The problem is that we have literature that was purchased over the last month that we need to pay our literature chair for, and if we donate that money prior to paying our literature chair, we will not have the funds allocated to pay our literature chair. We will be making a motion to use funds that were previously allocated to the literature budget to be used to pay the literature chair rather than being sent as part of our donation to region and world.

I have really appreciated the opportunity to serve this body as the vice treasurer over the last 2 years, I have learned a lot and I hope to continue to serve this body in any way I am able.
