**Treasurer:**

Hey Family,

I appreciate the opportunity to serve this area as the Treasurer. Over the last month, I met up with the chair and vice chair at Truist to get added onto the account and met with the outgoing treasurer to get access to the online bank account and the treasurer google drive. I believe I should be pretty well prepared for this role, but please do bear with me while I get familiar with some of the new responsibilities.

I have updated the ledgers and accounts to reflect the motion that passed last month to update the new budget allocations. I have attached the February report sheet to this email that should reflect these updates. If you have any questions about your subcommittee's budget or anything at all relating to the treasury or our accounts, please let me know, my phone number is at the bottom of the report.

Our new monthly allocated budget is \$1375. With that being said, last month we only brought in \$758.76 in donations (a shortfall of \$616.24). January had a number of meeting cancellations due to snow and last area was on Super Bowl Sunday, so I am hoping that we are able to make up some of that shortfall this month.

The bank balance as of 2/28 was \$18,931.96. This includes \$5113.49 from checks that have not yet been cashed by CARNA and World which are \$3579.49 and \$1534.07 respectively. Per the motion last month that passed, the expense sheet will reflect \$1216.97 that was paid to the literature chair at last area that was allocated to the previous year's budget and as such will not be charged to this year's budget allocation for the Literature chair. As a reminder, this was done as the money was actually spent in the previous fiscal year but due to our requirement to donate all remaining funds, would not have been allocated yet in the current fiscal year's literature subcommittee budget. This appears to be an issue that will recur at the end of each fiscal year, so I am going to try to find a solution and hope to have a motion ready for next area for a change in policy.

One of the topics was a request that was received from the VA Correctional Center requesting volunteers at the Dillwyn Correction Center and 25-Basic Texts and 25-Step Working Guides. We were not sure which area the Dillwyn CC belonged to. However, Piedmont volunteered to help fill the request for books and take them to the facility; New Dominion was asked to help, and I said yes. Region donated 11-Basic Texts. Piedmont and New Dominion RCMs agreed to take it back to our areas, with the intent of the two areas going half on the costs of the books and Piedmont would complete the paperwork received Dillwyn CC staff so the books could be delivered.

April 1st, 2026, is when the surveys for the CAR /CAT close. There is an attachment with the links to the surveys and to the CAR/CAT reports that can be viewed here. You will also find the detail information for the next in-person CAR-CAT presentation which is March 28. April 15th a discussion about the results of the CAR/CATA surveys we'll take place. Once again, check out the flyer, all the important dates and links are there in one place.
