### **Treasurer:**

Hey Family,

As a reminder, our new monthly allocated budget is \$1375. With that being said, last month we only brought in \$895.53 in donations (a shortfall of \$479.47). This is following another down month in January of \$758. We are still fiscally sound for now, but if we continue to have months with significantly lower donations, we may need to revisit budget allocations. Again, we are not there yet, but I will have a better idea of where we stand next month.

The bank balance as of 3/31 was \$17,039. This includes \$3579.49 from one check from CARNA that was cashed a couple days ago but was after 3/31 so does not reflect as a cashed check on this month's balance. It should reflect on next month's end of month statement.

Also, I went up to Truist to further discuss child accounts for campout and special events. I was told that child accounts don't technically exist, as such, however we could add a single separate account that we could have another signer on. However, we could only add one other account and it would require all of the current signers to show up again in person along with the new signer to open the new account. This would partially solve the problem for one subcommittee but would only work for one of the subcommittees.

My suggestion is for each subcommittee (most importantly campout and special events - but any subcommittee could theoretically do this if they have 2 or more members) to get their own EIN as an "Unincorporated Association" and set up their own business bank account for their subcommittee. There is no fee to get an EIN number and you do not need to be an incorporated entity. It also should be free to set up a simple business checking account with Truist, I really think this is the best way to approach this and it should allow an easier way to hold funds, track revenue, and accept payments. I am happy to assist these subcommittees to set this up if this is something they are interested in pursuing.

At this time, there is no policy written around this - the policy that we had written was stripped because it was based around creating a child account which isn't exactly possible as such. It may make sense to put together a new adhoc to include the chairs and treasurers of campout and special events as well as the policy chair and anyone else who is interested.
