### **Vice-Chair:**

Good Afternoon Everyone,

The rumor mill has been on overdrive this past week and I want to try to address it and hopefully limit its ability to interrupt our business here today...

We are all very fortunate that our predecessors created this Area and provided the framework in which we conduct our business. They set up homegroups, they created subcommittees to conduct business on behalf of the homegroups, they created the executive committee and policy to provide a structure and guidelines for the homegroups to come together and fulfill their primary purpose, and they created service positions to make sure the New Dominion Area stays connected to the rest of the world. They worked to set up conventions and campouts and pool parties, and all of this was done to save lives. The point has always been to show the newcomer that freedom from active addiction is not only possible, but can lead to a life beyond your wildest dreams. Our traditions tell us that "Our common welfare should come first, personal recovery depends on NA unity"...and the Basic Text says our "Unity is a must" because without unity this whole thing that our predecessors worked so hard to build can just fall apart.

The guidelines, or Policy, that they created was left intentionally loose so that each generation could reinterpret them and our Area could continue to grow and evolve, but they assume that we always remember why we are all here in the first place. The idea is that underregulation can lead to creative solutions to unforeseeable problems. When we start doing things just because "Policy says so", it takes the compassion out of recovery. Policy was never intended to provide clear guidance for every situation and recently different interpretations of the intent of Policy have challenged the unity of our Area.

Admittedly, I am not a policy expert, but my oversimplified version of the current situation is this...policy tasks the Area Treasurer with a full accounting of all NA funds, but does not require Special Events and Campouts subcommittees to return money used to put on events or any profits that are made at these events in a timely manner, which is preventing the Treasurer from fully accounting for all NA funds. In the past, these committees would come to Area and request funds, provide an accounting of expenses, and return any profits which were usually pretty minimal, but none of this is described in policy and as our predecessors have stepped back from service, their knowledge of the way they made things work has left with them. So last month we created an Ad Hoc subcommittee to explore options to allow the Treasurer to fulfill their responsibilities in accordance with policy. That subcommittee had its first meeting last weekend and I hear things maybe didn't go as smoothly as they could have.

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The fact of the matter is that we are all passionate about recovery and sometimes service aint easy...tempers flared, feelings got hurt, rumors and accusations spread like a wildfire and the Unity of our Area has been fractured. The question is how will we move forward? Will we allow ourselves to get mired down in distrust and accusations? Or will we remember that it's our Unity of purpose that brings us here and without that none of this would exist.

A saying that pisses me off like nothing else is "Area Circus", because it discounts the work that we and our predecessors put into building everything that many in our Area take for granted, but that is exactly where egos and distrust will lead us in times like these. So everyone here has a decision to make...look around the room, are you willing to trust our trusted servants, folks that voluntarily took time out of their weekend to be here? Are you open-minded enough to believe everyone here is just as passionate about recovery as you are? If so, let's squash this shit and get back to the business of saving lives!

With that being said...Last month, 34 out of 55 homegroups were in attendance and 24 GSRs were voting. So in accordance with Policy, we will need a minimum of 16 voting members in order to conduct business today.

### **Treasurer:**

Hey Family,

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Last month we had \$1551.07 in 7th Tradition donations. This is the first time this fiscal year that we met our monthly operating budget. As a reminder, our monthly operating budget is \$1375 and the two trailing months of donations were \$895.53 and \$758.76 respectively. We do still have plenty of money in our bank account thanks to our prudent reserve, but this does mean that there will not be a donation to CARNA this month as we do not have any surplus fund and technically are behind \$591.23. This is something that we will need to keep track of and watch carefully over the next few months.

Next, there is something that I need to address, and I am going to address it head on. As part of a separate ad hoc committee it has come to light that one of our subcommittees already has a bank account set up that they have been using to make purchases for their subcommittee. I want to be absolutely clear that I do not have any reason to believe that there is any misappropriation of funds or any impropriety, and this is not in any way an allegation of either against any individual or any subcommittee. I also want to be clear that I have a deep appreciation for all of the wonderful events put on by this subcommittee that I know were integral in me getting clean when I got here, and I have a deep love for the people who make up this subcommittee as individuals and as brothers and sisters in this fellowship. With all of that being said, my understanding of policy along with the traditions and concepts is that there is a singular point of accountability and this is especially true when it comes to oversight of NA funds. Further, in our policy, in section 2.d.iii, it indicates that "All NDANA funds will be held by and accounted for by the NDANA ASC Treasurer with oversight through the executive committee."

It is important to me both as a member of this fellowship and as an elected member of this administrative committee, that there is very clear transparency with all NA funds as these funds belong to the area and to all the GSRs that make up this area's conscience. I have been in touch with the subcommittee's treasurer to discuss getting access to their bank statements so that I can better understand what money is available and how it is being spent and so that this information can be reported on to the area body. As part of the administrative committee and as your elected ASC Treasurer, I believe it is critical that all funds held by this area have clear oversight and transparent reporting. I believe, in accordance with concept 2 and 6, the decision on how to proceed is not one that can or should be made by me nor by anyone else on the Administrative committee. Our only responsibility is to serve the GSRs of this area and to proceed based on the group conscience of such.

Vacant Positions are: Vice-Chair, Alternate Secretary, Special Events, Speaker Jam & PR committee. Two positions were filled: Vice Treasurer (Rick) and Policy Chair (Kim C.)

The next 2-day event for the region will be held in Quadrant 3 this year. Those dates are October 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Quadrant 3 consists of the Appalachian Area, New River Valley Area, Roanoke Valley Area, and Southside Area. The tentative agenda will be presented when we meet June 20, 2026.

The ad hoc committee was tasked with exploring how we can implement bank accounts for our area subcommittees while simultaneously allowing our Area Treasurer /Executive Committee oversight as trusted servants and transparency in handling area monies. My action item for this committee is to provide the contact information of the areas that are successfully using bank accounts for their subcommittees.

In closing, as I gain more experience at the regional level it's clearly visible that in comparison to other areas in the Central Atlantic Region that this area truly demonstrates in our actions to do all we can to carry the message of experience, strength, and hope of Narcotics Anonymous to those inside and outside our rooms.

### **Policy:**

Hi fam!

First things first, there are no positions up for election next month--and in fact, no more Area-level positions open traditionally until September.

With that out of the way, I've got several updates for y'all this month which I'm excited to share.

1. I had my first Policy Subcommittee meeting this past Thursday at 6:30 pm. Besides myself, 4 other addicts were in attendance, and it was very productive all things considered. I will continue to host these meetings virtually, via Zoom, at 6:30pm on the Thursday before ASC. The meeting was short, due to the time limit on free accounts, however there was a motion submitted today regarding an Area Zoom account, to be discussed during New Business. I would urge homegroups to strongly consider it, as it is difficult to conduct business when only allotted 30-40 minutes. During our meeting, I shared my plans for the subcommittee:
2. Aside from continuing our previous Policy Chair's work fixing formatting issues, I also intend to do my best to comb through policy for internal contradictions, confusing language, and any other areas of opportunity so that I can propose improvements to the ASC. Just as with

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recovery, I can't do it all on my own and I'd be a fool to try, so anyone interested in helping is more than welcome--newcomer and oldtimer alike.

3. As part of this effort to resolve internal policy contradictions, I would love to meet or speak with each existing subcommittee chair so I can obtain a copy of each subcommittee's own policy and better understand how things are actually being run in each. In doing this research, my sole purpose and motivation is to uncover where subcommittee practice, subcommittee policy, and area policy might be in conflict so that we can align all three. I'm not the NA police and I have no desire to be, all I want is to make sure we're all on the same page as an Area, and that our policy reflects that alignment.

4. I would also very much like to reduce the barrier to entry when it comes to Area-level service, and I believe Policy is a part of that. We have so many GSRs and subcommittee members with relatively little Area-level service experience, and frankly most people don't know or care about policy until it becomes a problem. So, I would love to partner with our Outreach Chair to introduce some kind of quick 1-2 page cheat sheet for newer members and anyone else who may appreciate a quick reference guide. I have printed a copy of the Napa Valley Area's Robert's Rules of Order cheat sheet as an EXAMPLE, which I'll pass around now--note that I would like to create our own, to ensure it's in alignment with our policy and practices. I did mention this to Bernadette just before ASC, though we'll need to discuss further.

5. Speaking of Robert's Rules of Order, I will be using the Policy Subcommittee budget to purchase a copy of the book to be handed down as NDANA Policy Subcommittee property.

6. I have created a Google Form to submit motions for review and passed it along to our Webservant who posted it on our website. Note that motions, to be actually submitted, must be made at ASC with the motion maker and their second present. The purpose of this Google Form is to allow motion makers, and the Policy subcommittee, time to review the wording and make adjustments or ask and answer questions about policy implications prior to area, with time to spare, rather than in a mad dash during the few minutes before ASC starts. It is of course not required to submit ahead of time, but I believe it will save us all time in the long run and it's there for your convenience. It can be found on RVANA.ORG under "Areas Served > New Dominion Area," scroll down to "Group Forms," and select "Online Motion Review Form."

7. Finally--and thanks for listening/reading so far, I know it's a lot--I encourage anyone with questions, concerns, or interest in policy to attend our next subcommittee meeting on June 11th at 6:30pm.

### **Bank Account Ad Hoc:**

Hey Family,

The purpose of this ad hoc committee is to find a sufficient solution for sub committees that balances appropriate oversight and sufficient ease of use that does not involve having to use personal bank accounts to collect money at NA functions and events as well as to provide policy change recommendations to support this purpose that will be voted on by home groups.

First, I will take ownership of the delay in setting up the first meeting. By the time I had reached out to the subcommittee chairs, the first ad hoc meeting ended up getting scheduled with less notice than I would have liked to accommodate the schedules of the subcommittee chairs. Going forward there will be plenty of notice given so that anyone who has an interest can participate. The meeting link will be included in the area minutes and will be communicated to the web servant to post online prior to the meeting.

We have reached out to the region for guidance on how other areas have dealt with this and have gotten some initial guidance on what has and has not worked in other areas. I intend to seek further guidance from other areas and from other experienced members to determine what policy changes were implemented to support similar accounts and on some pitfalls to avoid.
