I'm submitting a funds request for \$21.72 cents out of the Policy budget, as reimbursement for the Roberts Rules book and authorized "In Brief" version that I discussed last month.

Due to life events, I haven't yet been able to convert a Robert's Rules Cheat Sheet into something workable for our Area, but I aim to have that for y'all next month. Again, I know Policy isn't the most glamorous subcommittee, but one of the biggest goals I have for this subcommittee is to make things like ASC more accessible to the service newcomer, so the more help and diverse voices involved, the better.

I attended the Unified Public Relations Phone Line Workshop, not as Policy Chair just as a member of NA, but I did want to report that I thought it went very well, although I do wish we'd had more NDANA representation out there. The food was bangin, and it was very educational and inspiring.

I also attended the last half of the bank account ad hoc on July 11th and received a draft of some proposed changes from Scott M, which I'll be reviewing in depth for any other policy change implications or conflicts, clarity of wording, and things of that nature. I'll provide that feedback to Scott ahead of the next ad hoc meeting, and will attend that one in full in case of any further policy related questions or concerns.

The next Policy subcommittee meeting is August 6th at 6:30pm, on Zoom. I will provide updated meeting details on the website after I have a chance to reach out to our PR Chair to coordinate use of the Area Zoom account. I hope to see some of you there.

There is a website <https://narcotics.com> that impersonates Narcotics Anonymous for Profit to drive clients to their drug treatment clinics. They use old meeting data from our websites, and show as the top link when you search for NA meetings in most localities. In order to fight this misinformation, we would need to do a lot of changes. We would need to incorporate as a Non-Profit, a small fee and some paperwork. We would need to register our non-profit with LegitScript, the worldwide internet clearinghouse for legal protection and identification of websites, free to non-profits with small annual budgets. We could then get free Microsoft or Google for Non-Profits. Google for Non-Profits includes a 10K dollar ad budget for FREE, MONTHLY. We would then use our LegitScript to run PSA's on Google Ad Services and all other Ad networks (META etc). This would raise our ranking to highest as the official legal entity named Narcotics Anonymous with a website with high traffic in our area and our state, forcing our website to the top of search results. We could then inform LegitScript we are the only entity named Narcotics Anonymous in our area, and to de-rank Narcotics.com as an imposter (They are breaking LegitScript rules, but as long as we do nothing, there will be no action).

Bank Account Ad Hoc:

Hey Family,

The Subcommittee Bank account ad-hoc met on July 11th at 4pm as scheduled. There were 7 addicts in attendance and I believe we have made some substantial progress towards our goal.

After getting confirmation that it would be possible to create additional bank accounts with proper oversight, last month we made a motion to confirm that this is something that the area would like us to continue exploring.

I have gotten some feedback that despite the commentary that we had last meeting surrounding this motion, some GSRs were not clear on what this motion would do. This was not a motion to create these new bank accounts. This was simply a request that the home groups confirm they would like us to continue to explore our options and work on putting together policy that would support this endeavor.

To this end, the ad-hoc has made solid progress in working through some of the areas where policy would need to be addressed, changed or removed to further our stated purpose. Provided we receive the green light from GSRs to continue, we anticipate being able to present a comprehensive motion next month that will make the needed policy changes to accomplish the goal of creating these accounts.

If the home groups express their desire for us to continue this process, our next meeting is scheduled for Aug 2 at 4PM on zoom.

I have attached the minutes for the Adhoc meeting as well as the preliminary suggested changes to policy. If you have any thoughts, suggestions or questions, please let me know directly or show up at our next ad hoc meeting. Please note these suggested changes are in the preliminary stage and do not constitute a motion. The goal is to formalize and finalize the motion that would include this information at our next adhoc meeting to present at the August ASC meeting.
