All is well with Treasurer. Our donation income for last month was \$1337.83. As a reminder our monthly budget allocations are \$1375. We are at about the true halfway point in our fiscal year, and there are a number of subcommittee budgets that have a lot of allocated money that has not yet been spent. If you have any questions about your subcommittee's budget, please let me know and I am happy to discuss it with you. Additional updated information is provided as part of the treasurer financial report that goes out with the minutes each month.

There is one uncashed check:
Check 1810 - Special Events: \$1500 for the pool party which is next weekend.

Most of our money is allocated, however, we will be able to make a donation to CARNA of \$51.86

I also participated in the Ad hoc meeting for the subcommittee bank accounts and will provide a report on that later.

Also, I had an opportunity to review our insurance policy in detail. There are exclusions for: animals, fireworks, swimming in bodies of water other than guarded public pools, hay rides, boating, fishing, jetskiing, physical abuse, molestation and outdoor camping with or without tents. These exclusions do open us up for liability.

The last exclusion -campouts- is my biggest concern. I have asked our insurance agent if we could remove that exclusion and was told no that is not an option, so I asked for a quote on what it would cost to get event specific insurance. That came in right around \$500 for the weekend. If there is time in open

Safety and Belonging/Gender-Neutral Language" project update:

As part of the "Safety and Belonging/Gender-Neutral Language" project, the world has issued their first draft, which is a revision to IP #1 - Who, What, How, and Why. The following revisions are being suggested/ proposed:

1) Who is An Addict?

- Changing "an addict is a man or woman" to "an addict is a person"

2) What is the NA Program

- Changing "fellowship or society of men and women" to "fellowship or society of people"

3) What is the NA Program

- Changing "regardless of age, race, sexual identity, creed, religion, or lack of religion" to "regardless of age, race, gender, sexual identity, creed, religion, or lack of religion"

4) Why Are We Here?

- Changing "ahead of our families, our wives, husbands, and our children." to "ahead of our families and loved ones."

Changes to this one IP will most likely cascade out into other pieces of literature that reference these readings. They include, but are not limited to: The Basic Text, the Group reading cards, IP 29 - An introduction to NA Meetings, the booklets "An Introductory Guide to Narcotics Anonymous" and "NA White Booklet - Narcotics Anonymous".

Policy:

Good afternoon fam,

Due to a last-minute conflict, I did have to move the Policy Subcommittee meeting this past Thursday up to 5:30 from the normal 6:30 timeslot. I communicated this to our Webservant who updated the website that same morning. Unfortunately, one person tried to attend at 5:30 but used an old link, and another couple missed the website banner and joined at 6:30, so there were no addicts in attendance with me even though there was some actual interest for once, go figure. Our next meeting will be Thursday, September 10th at 6:30pm.

I also attended the ad hoc for subcommittee bank accounts on August 2nd, and reviewed my document of recommendations and clarifying questions with those present. The ad hoc's original proposal contained a number of proposed policy items, most of them so deeply intertwined that they could not be broken into smaller motions, and I did my best to identify all other areas of policy influenced or impacted by the proposed changes. Aside from the actual content of the motion, I also suggested some formatting changes for the monetary section of our policy for better readability.

In other news, I was skimming through the Guide to Local Services in NA and came across a concept of a policy log, which gave me an idea that I wanted to run by this ASC. While the Guide's referring to an action log, I'd like to suggest that we create and maintain a more general policy log. The log would exist as a historical record of major policy changes (including their intent statements), but also if the Area has questions or disagreements about an element of policy and reach an agreement on interpretation, that understanding could be recorded for future reference. While we would not be bound by the historical log the way that we are by policy, it would help us create more informed decisions and
